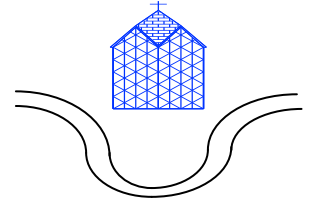

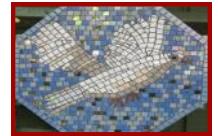

## Is your child wearing their house team t-shirt during PE?

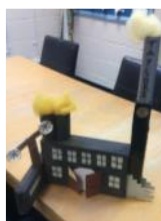
T-shirts are still available to purchase from the school office every Monday from 3:30pm.
