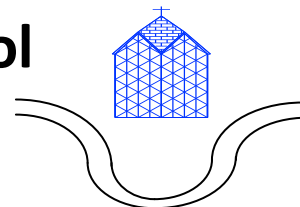
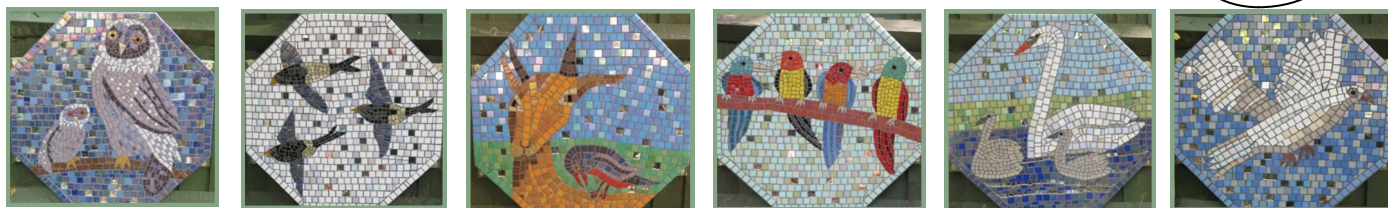


# St Paul with St Luke C of E Primary School
