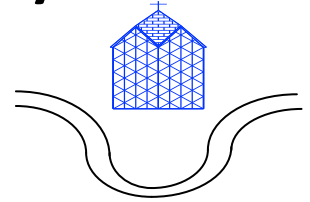

Donations can include:

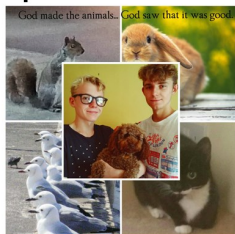
Non-perishable Foods—e.g. tinned foods, dry foods and staple items.
