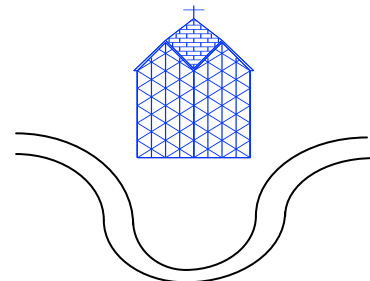

In Nursery this term we are concentrating on teaching all areas of the curriculum through the topic, All About Me.



Literacy

We will be reading a range of books, both fiction and non-fiction to explore our topic. We will be finding out different aspects of 'All about me' through writing, reading, art and role play activities.



This term the children will be concentrating on recognising their names. Please encourage them to find their name each morning and self register before they read a book on the carpet.

In Phonics, we are using learning all about listening in our environment as well as learning rhymes and musical rhythms!

We will encourage the children to use the Read Write Inc. frieze to find the letters in their names. These have a range of pictures which help the children to learn to recognise the letters.



Mathematics

We will be using our Core Books to help us with our learning in mathematics too! Children will be counting and sorting objects, using this as an opportunity to see how many they have altogether. The children will begin to learn 2D shapes and will be encouraged to look for shapes in the environment!

Religious Education

This term we will be learning all about stories from the Bible as well as the holidays that happen in the autumn.

Areas of learning

There are many other areas of learning in the EYFS curriculum including; singing, role play, drawing and painting, climbing, running, cutting, sticking, playing with small world toys such as farm animals and train sets.

We strongly encourage every child to take part in every area of the curriculum.



Learning at Home

To help encourage your child to continue their learning at home they will be receiving their own Learning Log. Each week the children will be given an activity that reinforces what we have been learning in Nursery. These activities will support your child's learning and help them to become ready to read and write as well as count.
