

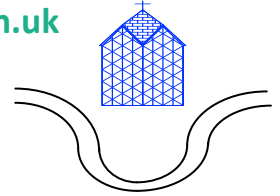

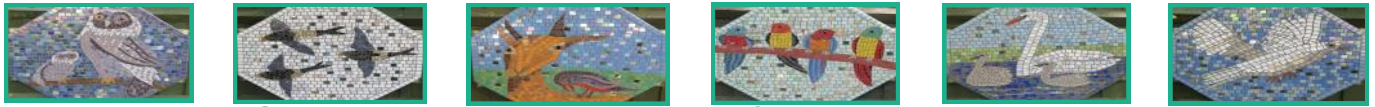

SCHOOL UNIFORM REMINDER:

Only plain black shoes or trainers. Pupils may change into their non-school uniform trainers if required in PE or in Sports / Football Club.

- ✓ White shirt/polo shirt or House Team Colours (Yellow, Blue, Green or Red)
- ✓ Navy or grey trousers, skirts, leggings, dresses, tights
- ✓ Plain black shoes or trainers
- ✓ White socks
- ✓ Plain black or grey headscarf (if worn)
- ✓ No Jewellery (except small stud earrings)
- ✓ No make up (including nail varnish)
