

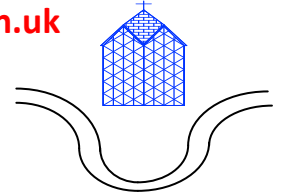

Mother Bernadette and Aimee are researching local need for a foodbank. All parents/Carers welcome! Please join us. A food bank is a non-profit organization that collects and distributes food to hunger-relief charities. Food banks act as food storage and distribution depots for smaller front line agencies; and usually do not themselves give out food directly to people struggling with hunger.

Care professionals such as doctors, health visitors, schools and social workers identify people in crisis and issue them with a foodbank voucher. This entitles them to receive a foodbank parcel of three days' nutritionally balanced, non-perishable food. Foodbanks also offer a lot more than food.
