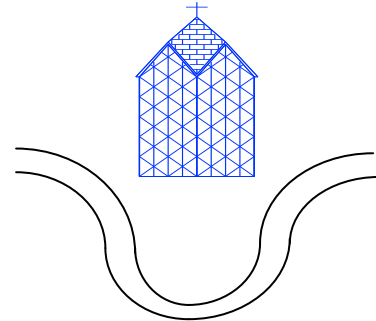

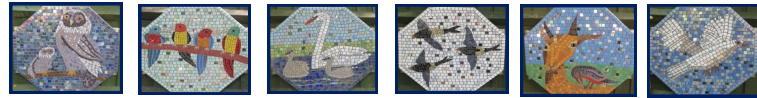

In Nursery this term we are concentrating on teaching all areas of the curriculum through the topic, *Animals*.

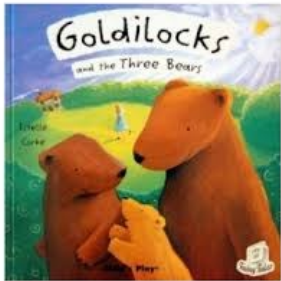


Religious Education

Other Areas of the EYFS

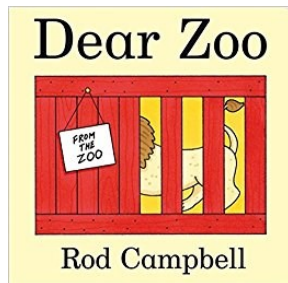
We will be covering all areas of the curriculum through our topic of Animals. Children will have opportunities to sing, role play, draw, paint, climb, run, cut, stick and play with small world. All children are encouraged to access all areas of the curriculum. The children's learning will also be enhanced by some special educational visits including duck eggs and Safari Pete as well as a trip to a farm.



Literacy
We will be reading a number of books with animal characters. Children will continue to develop their story telling skills through the use of story maps. Children will have lots of opportunities to explore different

aspects of the books through writing, reading, art and role play activities.

This term the children will continue to recognise their names, and begin to write their names too! Please encourage and support them to find their name and write it each morning!



In Phonics, we are starting to introduce letter sounds by listening to the sound at the beginning middle and end of a word. We will encourage the children to use the Read Write Inc. frieze to find the letters in their names. These have a range of pictures which help the children to learn to recognise the letters.

Mathematics



We will be using our Core Books to help us with our learning in mathematics. Children will be counting and sorting objects and counting how many they have altogether. The children will begin to learn the names and properties of 2D shapes and will be encouraged to look for shapes in the environment!
