



## <u>Literacy</u>

We will be reading non-fiction, fiction and poetry linked to our Topic: Rise of the Robots! Children will write character descriptions, poetry, debate and argument letters and reports/newspapers.

In terms of grammar, we will be focusing on appropriate nouns and pronouns, using a wider range of conjunctions, adverbs and prepositions in our writing. We will also focus on punctuation such as full stops, question marks, commas, exclamation marks, speech marks and apostrophes.

## <u>Maths</u>

In maths we will be working on: multiplication and division.

We will also be focusing on decimals, fractions, area, and measurement.

In addition we will

be developing our mental maths skills through the Big Maths CLIC sessions, as well as learning our times tables.



## <u>Science</u>

In Science this term, we are learning about Electricity. The children will learn to construct simple series circuits, trying different components, for example, bulbs, buzzers and motors, including switches, and use their circuits to create simple devices.

## Topic—Rise of the Robots

Children will learn about what a Robot is, the different types of Robots that exist and the jobs they do. They will also find out, not only how robots help humans around the world but also how they have affected our world and technology.



## <u>RE</u>

Our RE theme for this term is: What Do The Miracles of Jesus Teach Us? We will be exploring the miracles of Jesus and the message they give, as well as other people who have been said to have performed miracles.

We will also be learning about the Beatitudes and their message.
