Instrument of Government

1. The name of the school is St Paul with St Luke England Primary School
2. The school is a Voluntary Aided School.
3. The name of the governing body is: "The governing body of St Paul with St Luke Church of England School".
4. The governing body shall consist of:
 - a. Two parent governors;
 - b. One LA governor
 - c. One head teacher
 - d. Seven foundation governors (to outnumber total of other categories by two.)
5. Total number of governors: 12.
6. Foundation Governors shall be appointed as follows:
 - a. Two appointed by the London Diocesan Board for Schools;
 - b. Two appointed by the Parochial Church Council of St Paul with St Luke;
 - c. Two appointed by the Tower Hamlets Deanery Synod.
7.
 - a. The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex-officio: Minister of St Paul with St Luke, Bow Common
 - b. The Archdeacon of Hackney shall be entitled to appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex-officio governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that the ex-officio governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 21 (1) of the Regulations.
8. The Archdeacon of Hackney shall be entitled to request the governing body to remove the ex-officio foundation governor referred to in 7a above and to appoint any substitute governor.

8. Ethos Statement:

9. Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with the Church at parish and diocesan level.

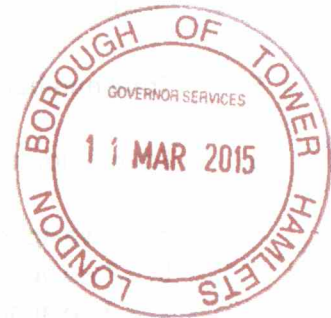

13. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body (and head teacher if not a governor), any trustees and to the London Diocesan Board of Schools.

- Seven foundation governors (an outer number of other categories by two)

Total number of governors: 12

Foundation Governors shall be appointed as follows:

- Two appointed by the London Diocesan Board for Schools
- Two appointed by the Parochial Church Council of St Paul with St Luke
- Two appointed by the Tower Hamlets Diocesan Society

The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor & officer:

- Minister of St Paul with St Luke, Bow Common

The Archbishop of Harkney shall be entitled to appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex-officio governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that the ex-officio governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 21 (1) of the Regulations.

The Archbishop of Harkney shall be entitled to request the governing body to remove the ex-officio foundation governor referred to in (a) above and to appoint any other person to the office.
