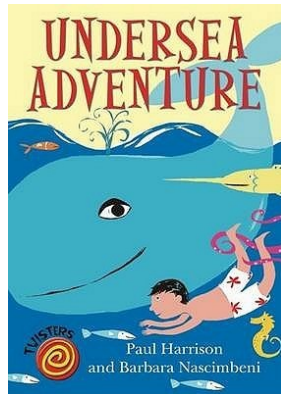

In Nursery this term we are concentrating on teaching all areas of the curriculum through the topic, 'Under The Sea'

Literacy

We will be reading a number of fiction and non fiction texts to help us build up knowledge and understanding of our new topic.



Children will continue to develop their story telling skills through the use of story maps and will also innovate and begin to invent their own stories. Children will be given lots of opportunities to explore different aspects of the books through reading, writing, art and role play.



This term the children will continue to practise writing their names. When they can do this

independently they will have their photo added to our wall and a certificate will be sent home. Please encourage and support them to find their name at home too!

In Phonics the children will continue to learn about discriminating sounds. They will develop their ability to hear and identify the initial sounds in words and rhyming words. Children will begin to explore oral blending and segmenting.



Mathematics

We will be using our Core Books to help us with our learning in mathematics. Children will continue to count and sort objects. They will learn about quantities and continue to recognise numerals. The children will revise the names and properties of 2D shapes and move on to learning about 3D shapes. Children will be encouraged to look for shapes in their environment too!



Religious Education

This term we will continue to learn all about Jesus and his life. We will link the Bible stories to our school values. We will also be learning about the Muslim festival of Eid.

Other areas of the Early Years Foundation Stage

We will be covering all areas of the curriculum through our topic of Under the Sea. We will be finding out about different under the sea creatures, what they eat, where they hide and completing a range of art activities. All children are encouraged to access every area of the curriculum. The children's learning will also be enhanced with a drama workshop.
