

ideas together in paragraphs. We will also learn how to use punctuation appropriately, particularly inverted commas when using direct speech n our written texts.


Mathematics

Please ensure your child wears the correct PE kit on these days. if children do not come in correct PE kit, they may not be able to take part in the lesson.


Music, French and Computing .
