

### Literacy

In our literacy lessons, we will be using the story History Hackers Roman rescue, a journey tale. We will be writing descriptions and narratives. We will then be looking at and writing non-chronological reports and leaflets. Linked to our history topic. In grammar, we will be focusing on expanded noun phrases, similes, and also focusing on punctuation, such as, full stops, question marks, commas and exclamation marks.

### **Numeracy**

In numeracy, we will be working on place value of 4 digit numbers and round. We will also focus on the four operations: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

In addition we will be developing our mental

Maths skills through learning our time tables. We will also practise doubles, near doubles, multiplication and division facts.



### Science

This term in Science we will be looking at our digestive system! We will enquire about where food goes inside our bodies, how food is broken down, modelling the digestive system, the types of teeth we have and question why we have different types of teeth.

Then, we will analyse the science of sounds! Students will investigate how sounds are made, how sounds travel, how sounds can be made louder and quieter, how we can change the pitch of a sound and much more. This unit ties in nicely with our music learning.

# History Rampaging Romans

This Romans unit will teach your child about the impact the Roman empire had on life in Britain: our roads, food, plumbing, among many others! They will learn about the spread of the Roman empire, the invasion of Britain and the eventual conquest. Next, we will learn about a fearsome, female warrior - Boudicca and will act in role to look at the events of Boudicca's rebellion from different perspectives. The children will also investigate Hadrian's Wall,

examining how,
where and why it was
built. Children will
learn about the
different features of
the wall and use maps

to determine its location.

#### RE

Our first RE theme for this term is: What is it like to be a Sikh? We will be learning about the special place of worship called a Gurdwara and the importance of the 5Ks. We will also see what similarities and differences there are between Sikhism and Christianity.

#### PF

On **Wednesday** our specialist sports coach will teach PE. Please make sure children come into school wearing their PE kit and wear their correct colour house team T-shirt. These are available from the office.
