English

In English, the children will be using the core text 'The Stone Age Boy' by Satoshi Kitamaru. This is a journey tale of a young boy who travels back in time to the Stone Age. We will innovate the story and for our writing outcome produce a 5 part story. In Grammar, we will be focusing on expanded noun phrases, subordinate clauses as well as punctuation.

Maths

In Maths, this half term we will be focussing on,

- Place Value
- Addition and subtraction using 3 digit and 2 digit numbers.

Next half term we will be focussing on:

 Addition and subtraction using 3 digit and 2 digit numbers.

 Multiplication and Division with a focus on multiples of 3, 4 and 8.



History

In History, children will be studying the changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. We will explore the similarities and differences of each of the Ages (Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age).

Geography

In Geography, children will be studying Map and Fieldwork skills while exploring the physical and human features of the UK. This includes learning the 8 points on a compass.

Science

In science we will be learning about Rocks. We will learn the scientific names of different types of rocks and understand how they were formed.

Art

In Art we will be drawing and painting while learning the skills to invent, repeat marks and mix colours.

DT

In DT our topic is Textiles. We will explore ways to stiffen fabric. We will create a rigid box out of fabric.

RE

In RE the children will explore the Big Question, What is the Bible's big story? We will look at the features of a Bible and learn about the core concepts of Creation and Fall.

PE

We will be learning skills to play ball games on Wednesdays with a professional coach. On Fridays we will learn skills to play games in teams.

Please ensure that your child wears their full PE kit (including appropriate footwear) so that they are able to participate safely!

Music/PHSE/Art/DT/MFL & Computing

During music the children will be leaning about tone and pitch. In PHSE they will be learning about themselves and what makes them unique. In Art we will be using different media to draw and paint. DT will be construction, mechanisms and textiles, as well as cooking. All children from nursery to Year 6 will be learning French during MFL (Modern Foreign Language). The children will using their IT skills to code and learning all about computer hardware and how to use different programmes

Homework

Children will be set homework every Friday in their Learning Log which is to be returned back on Wednesdays.

Your child's reading target is: To read daily for between 20-30 mins (longer if you can!).

You can help your child achieve their target by checking they are reading everyday and making a note in their yellow reading diary.
